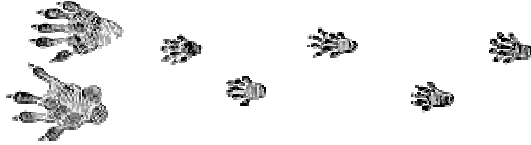

LIST OF CAMP ATTRACTIONS

MOUNT/WOOD CLIMBING TOWER

An outdoor wood climbing tower and a simulated rock indoors climbing wall is available. Weather will dictate which one will be operated. Helmets and harnesses are provided at no cost.

RIFLE RANGE

.22 Caliber target shooting at an outdoor range. There is a cost of \$0.75 per 10 shots. Tickets may be purchased at the camp store.

ARCHERY RANGE

Archery shooting at an outdoor range. Bow and arrows are provided. There is no cost for this event.

HORSEBACK RIDING

A 45-minute trail ride is available. Children 7 years and older may ride single, children under 7 yrs. may ride double with a Dad (or accompanied by a Dad walking). A 10-minute lesson and helmets are provided. Reservations are strongly recommended and may be made at the camp store. The cost is \$8.00 for a single rider.

THE BLACK HOLE

2 large outdoor slides. (If your daughter's like mine she will wear you out walking up that hill to slide again.)

FISHING

In the lake or the river. Bring your own gear and bait. Adults must have an Indiana Fishing License.

THERE ARE ALSO BASKETBALL COURTS, TENNIS COURTS, TETHERBALL, A SOCCER FIELD, A BASEBALL FIELD, A NATURE CENTER AND MANY MILES OF BEAUTIFUL HIKING TRAILS.

2008 MAD Moon Campout Campout Checklist

1. Bedding (sleeping bag or blankets) and pillow.
2. Favorite bedtime toy for Dad or daughter.
3. Towels and toilet articles to wash and brush with.
4. Flashlight with extra batteries.
5. Camera with film
6. Wear clothes for fall recreation. Dress for the weather and outdoor activity. Bring extra clothes for changing due to weather or accident. Fall campout: boots, jacket, gloves, hat, scarf. Weather can be cold, cool or warm so please dress appropriately.
7. Circle Display
8. Circle Assignments (Puddin' Head, games, awards etc).
9. Snacks
10. Princess awards (one per princess in attendance plus one extra, minimum 5)
11. Rain Gear.
12. Best Circle Awards.
13. No alcohol allowed! Camp Tecumseh YMCA prohibits the possession or use of alcohol by any member of a group. Any Circle found to be in violation will not be allowed to participate in the Winter Campout!

Circle Event Princess Prize / Craft

The princess prize competition will be judged based upon the princesses selection of the prizes. The first Tribe that has five prizes selected will receive first place. The first four Circles to have five prizes selected will receive ribbons for first through fourth place.

Adventure Guide Game winners will be allowed to pick prizes first. The order of selection will be first place winners from Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and then 5th grade. This will continue until second through fourth place winners have selected prizes. The remaining prizes will be picked by tribe. Circle order will be determined by drawing Circle names from a hat. All princesses from the selected Circle will then pick their princess prize.

Each Circle is required to bring to the campout a quantity of Princess Award/Craft equal to the number of Princesses from their Circle attending the campout plus one. Prior to the Awards Ceremony on Sunday all Princesses wishing to participate in the princess Award/Craft SWAP, will place their craft on the table and wait for their Circle to be called for craft selection. There will be no points awarded at this time. If a Princess does not want to participate in the craft swap she will just keep the craft she brought to the campout.

Any Circle that violates the following restrictions regarding Princess Awards/Craft will receive no points in scoring:

- *NO candy or food of any kind.
 - *NO stones or certificate for stones
 - *NO live animals
 - *NO cosmetics
 - *All Awards/Craft must be made in part by the Princesses
- Purchased items must be assembled or have value added by the Circle.

Any violation of the above will result in no score.

Circle Event Navigators Hunt

On Sunday at 9:15 AM the Chief's Hunt will begin. All Navigators and their daughters will meet in the dining hall of the main lodge to receive instructions. The Chiefs and their daughters will hide around the campground. Each Circle will need to find each Circle and receive from them some type of memento. Once all Chiefs are found by a Circle, the Circle is to return to the main lodge and turn in their mementos. This will be a timed event. A Circle's time will be divided by the number of Dad's in the Circle participating to determine the fastest time. The MicMac Tribe will provide all the Chiefs with the mementos to be given out.

Circle Game #1

Circle Game #2

To be determined by the Fox.

Best Circle Competition

Best Circle is based on results of the following:

Princess Awards, Circle Games 1 & 2, and Navigators' Hunt Events.

The scores of these individual competitions will be tabulated and the 4 Circles with the highest overall point totals will receive the 1st through 4th place. Coin toss will determine which Circle takes the trophy home in case of a tie for any one place. Every attending member of the 1st place "BEST CIRCLE" will receive a "BEST CIRCLE" patch. Every attending Princess in the 1st through 4th place "BEST CIRCLE" will receive a stone.

In addition, the 4 Circles with the highest overall point totals in each of the individual competitions will receive 1st through 4th place ribbons. Duplicate ribbons will be awarded in case of ties. Circle Navigators Chiefs are not allowed to score their own tribe in any competition. Points for each event will be awarded 15 points for 1st place, 10 points for 2nd place, 9 points for 3rd place, 8 points for 4th place, 7 points for 5th place, 6 points for 6th place, 5 points for 7th place, 4 points for 8th place and 3 points for 9th place.

Enforcement

Enforcement of the campout rules and procedures is the responsibility of the Nation Navigator. Any Circle or individual with a protest will be given full opportunity to voice and explain it to the Nation Navigator. Every effort will be made to maintain their anonymity. The Nation navigator will then discuss the protest with the Circle against which it was made. After receiving all available information, the Nation Navigator will make a ruling. Any decisions made by the Nation Navigator are final. The Nation Navigator may disqualify a Circle from an event or game for cheating, unsportsmanlike conduct, or violating the Campout Rules and Procedures.

Puddin Head

The Cheyenne will be assigned the responsibility of bringing a Puddin Head to the campout. It must be soft and padded so as not to cause injury if it hits a little Princess. Puddin Head may only be handled by the Princesses. Puddin Head may not be hidden. Circles may not lock or block their cabin doors to prevent Puddin Head from being put in their cabin.
