## **BEST CIRCLE COMPETITION**

### **OVERALL COMPETITION JUDGING**

The outcome of the following events determines the "BEST CIRCLE":

- SONG OR SKIT
- PRINCESS GAMES
- ADVENTURE PRINCESS AWARDS

The scores of these individual competitions will be tabulated by the host Circle (Cayuga) and verified by the Nation Circle Leader. The 4 Circles with the highest overall point totals will receive the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place "BEST CIRCLE" designation. Coin toss will determine which Circle wins in case of a tie for any one place. Every attending Adventure Princess in the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place "BEST CIRCLE" will receive a stone.

In addition, the 4 Circles with the highest overall point totals in each of the individual competitions will receive 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place ribbons. Duplicate ribbons will be awarded in case of ties. Tribal Circle Leaders are not allowed to score their own Circle in any competition.

NOTE: Circles which do not perform their camp responsibilities will not be eligible in the "BEST CIRCLE" competition.

### **SONG OR SKIT**

### **PRINCESS GAMES**

Games will be held for each grade level K - 4 and Circles will be given points for finishing first through fourth in each of these games.

### **ADVENTURE PRINCESS AWARD JUDGING**

Adventure princess Awards will be judged by the daughters. Daughters will be called up in an order to be determined. 1st place will be awarded to the first Circle to have five awards chosen by various girls. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded to Circles in succession. The Adventure Princesses may select without restriction from any of the Adventure Princess Awards brought to the camp out.

Each Circle is required to bring to the camp out a quantity of Adventure Princess Awards equal to the number of Adventure Princess from their Circle attending the camp out plus one extra. Any awards remaining after every Adventure Princess has received one will be retained by the Circle that brought them. Adventure Princess Awards shall be selected on Sunday morning at 11:00 a.m.

Any Circle which violates the following restrictions regarding Adventure Princess Awards will receive no points in scoring:

- No candy or food of any kind
- No stones or certificates for stones
- No live animals
- No money
- No cosmetics

All awards must be made in part by the Adventure Princesses. Purchased items must be assembled or have value-added by the Circle.

The display of the awards may not be misleading by displaying other items not to be received as part of the award.

Any person claiming that a Adventure Princess Award violates a restriction must make his claim known to the Nation Circle Leader prior to the Adventure Princess Awards presentation. No objections may be made after the Adventure Princess have begun selecting the Adventure Princess Awards. The Nation Circle Leader must allow the Circle an opportunity to respond to the objection before ruling on the objection. The Nation Circle Leader's decision to disqualify a Adventure Princess Award is final. Both the objecting and violating Circles will be kept anonymous. The Adventure Princess must not be told of any Adventure Princess Award objections or disqualifications.

## **PUDDIN' HEAD (Run by the Cayuga)**

Beginning on Saturday at 1 p.m. this event will begin. One Circle will be assigned the responsibility of bringing a Puddin' Head to the camp out. It must be soft and padded so as not to cause injury if it hits a little Adventure Princess. Puddin' Head may only be handled by the Adventure Princess. Puddin' Head may not be hidden. Circles may not lock or block their cabin doors to prevent Puddin' Head from being put in their cabin.

## **RULE ENFORCEMENT**

Enforcement of the campout rules and procedures is the responsibility of the Nation Circle Leader ("LETS PLAY NICE"). Any Circle or individual with protests will be given full opportunity to voice and explain them to the Nation Circle Leader. Every effort will be made to maintain their anonymity. The Nation Circle Leader will then discuss the protest with the Circle against which it was made. After receiving all available information, the Nation Circle Leader will make a ruling. Any decisions made by the Nation Circle Leader are final. The Nation Circle Leader may disqualify a Circle from an event or game for cheating, unsportsmanlike conduct, or violating the Camp out Rules and Procedures.

Directions to Camp Matawa  
N885 Youth Camp Road  
Campbellsport, WI  
(262) 626-2149

- Leave Elmhurst via 294 North (Tri-State Tollway) towards Milwaukee
- Tollway turns into 1-94/US-41 in Wisconsin
- Just before Milwaukee (**exit 316 - ramp to the left**) take **1-43/I-894 bypass towards Madison/Fond du Lac**
- Stay to the right and continue on 1-894/I-45 towards Fond u Lac. In 5 miles 1-43 will exit to the left (do not take 1-43).
- At exit 1A the road changes into US-41/US-45. **Stay to the right heading toward Fond du Lac (I-41/I-45)**, not toward Madison
- 11 miles up the road, US-41 and US-45 split. Take **US-45 (right split) towards West Bend**
- Follow **US-45 North** (18 miles) past West Bend and into Kewaskum
- 2 ½ miles north of Kewaskum **turn right on Old Bridge Road. There is an electrical substation on the corner of County Road and US 45.**
- One mile (**first stop sign**) **turn left onto County Road G.**
- Two miles on County Road G to **Youth Camp Road and turn right.** There is an informational **sign for the YMCA Camp (follow it).**
- **Camp Matawa entrance 1 mile on left.** Camp sign on the road along with a YMCA Camp informational sign
- **Check in at the Main Office Building** - first building on the right past the stables

**2 ½ hour drive time from Elmhurst with a short pit stop**
